The search committee for the CALS Associate Dean of Academic Programs is pleased to announce the interview dates for three outstanding candidates. These candidates will be interviewed on campus on January 9, 10 and 11. Exact timing of interview schedules will be forthcoming, but we encourage you to participate in their open forums which will be held in Marley 230 from 3:30 to 5:00 p.m. on January 9, 10, and 11, as we will be seeking input from the broader CALS and statewide community.

Each candidate will meet with multiple CALS groups and they will give a 20 to 30 minute presentation on “The future of Academic Programs in CALS” followed by at least an hour of questions from the audience. These presentations will be made available online and videotaped. There will be a process for asking online questions.

January 9 - Bobby Torres

Dr. Torres started his career as a teacher of Agricultural Education in Willcox and has held positions in Agricultural Education at New Mexico State University and the University of Missouri before coming to the University of Arizona in 2010 to assume the position of Professor and Head of the Department of Agricultural Education in CALS.

January 10 - Joy Winzerling

Dr. Winzerling has spent most of her academic career at the University of Arizona and from 1986 to 1990 was an Assistant to the Dean of the office of Academic Programs in CALS. She is currently Professor and Head of the Department of Nutritional Sciences in CALS.

January 11 - Elaine Marchello

Dr. Marchello has spent most of her academic career at the University of Arizona. From 2008 to 2011 she was Assistant Dean of Academic Program in CALS and is currently Professor of Practice in the Department of Veterinary Science and Interim Dean of Academic Programs in CALS.
