What is Schedule for Success?

S4S is a program to support approximately 300 non-resident students during their first year of college*. The program offers critical learning support in coursework, exclusive math classes, financial aid counseling, and tutoring opportunities for new freshman students who place into Math 100AX on the UA Math Placement (ALEKS) test.

*The Math 100AX and SAS 100AX portion of S4S will be available for approximately 200 resident students. The pilot of additional student services will focus on non-residents this year.

What might a S4S class schedule look like?

MATH 100AX: Preparation for University Level Mathematics - 2 units**

SAS 100X: Math Success Strategies - 1 unit

ENGLISH - 3–4 units

TIER1 TRAD: VSC 160D1 - 3 units

Courses required by your academic college - 3–6 units

Math 100AX and SAS 100AX

These two courses have been co-developed to prepare students to move toward the foundations mathematics requirement for graduation.

**After 7.5 weeks in Math 100AX, students will have the opportunity to test into Math 100B and earn an additional 2 units which provides university credit.

Tier I Traditions & Culture Class

S4S students will also be enrolled in VSC 160D1: Human and Animal Interrelationships from Domestication to the Present. This class is taught by Dr. Elaine Marchello, Assistant Dean in the College of Agriculture & Life Sciences.

Plan for Success

To help support S4S students in their first year of college, they will get exclusive access to a professional Learning Specialist at the THINK TANK. Like having a private study coach, these individualized sessions will help them become familiar with their academic habits and learn new study strategies.

Support for Success

To help S4S students navigate financial aid, scholarships, and financial planning for college, they will have access to a specialized financial aid counselor, Jamie Uhrlaub.
