## **Career Development Opportunities:**

The Honors College helps students discover career options, learn about and prepare for medical school, law school, and other graduate programs, and make the most of internship opportunities. Session leaders will also discuss the Honors Civic Engagement Teams, a unique way for students to develop marketable skills while gaining real-world experiences beyond the classroom.

## **Research Opportunities:**

What is research? How can I get involved with research at the University of Arizona? What does research look like in the sciences? What does it look like in the humanities? How about in the social sciences, or engineering, or business, or the arts, or education? Come learn about the myriad of opportunities available for engaged students to delve into research as early as the first semester of college.

Honors Parents can talk with the Dean Patricia MacCorquodale about what they and their students can expect from their connection to The Honors College. This session will be interactive, so come with your questions!

## **Study Abroad:**

Are you thinking about studying abroad during your undergraduate career? Come to this session to learn about Honors-specific study abroad opportunities (in Guatemala, Germany, Greece, Singapore, and Namibia), as well as a range of other study abroad programs for Honors and non-Honors students alike.

## **Honors Parent Panel (Parents Only):**

What is it like to be an Honors parent? How can you best navigate the transition that both you and your student will undergo in the next few months? Interact directly with Honors parents who have been in your shoes in the past few years, anticipating the beginning of their students' transition to The Honors College at The University of Arizona.

## **How to Talk to Faculty (Students Only):**

Honors students enter college with a proven track record of academic success, yet many feel uncertain, and even shy, about engaging directly with faculty members. Connecting with faculty can be among the most rewarding experiences college students can have- they can become mentors and serve as references, among other things- so come to this session if you are eager to hear about making the most of relationships with faculty members.
