Honors Rotations Session Descriptions

The Honors Plan: Discussion of the ways in which students can customize their unique paths towards graduation with Honors. Students will be introduced to both the requirements and the unique academic and engagement opportunities available to Honors students.

Honors Schedule Review: Students will have an additional opportunity to review their Fall schedule in the ILC. They will add the required one-unit Honors Seminar and consult with Honors and Placement advisors about any other questions/concerns they may have.

The First Year Experience: Students will get a preview of what to expect as an Honors Freshman. They learn about one-unit Honors Seminars, Honors Advising, the First Year Project, mentoring opportunities, and social activities/events.

Common Reading: Students will receive this year's Common Reading selection, *Planetwalker*. Through a discussion led by the Honors Student Engagement Team and current Honors students, the freshman class will be introduced to the 2013 Common Reading theme, The Examined Life. Selected by Honors students, Common Reading is the thematic foundation for the Honors First Year Program, ranging from classes and seminars to engagement opportunities and social events.
