Who May Apply:

All eligible students are urged to apply. Eligible students are those who are currently enrolled or have been accepted to an accredited college or university other than the University of Hawaii at Manoa, and will be pursuing a degree (Associate, Bachelor, Master or PhD) in an agricultural science program or a related discipline (such as botany, genetics, horticulture, plant physiology, crop science or soil science) with an intent to pursue a career in agriculture. University of Hawaii at Manoa or Oregon State University students, please see Monsanto Scholarship program for scholarship information.

While preference is given to residents of Hawaii or a Pacific Island nation, the scholarship program is open to all eligible students.

Selection Criteria:

Applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered:

- Minimum 3.0 grade point average.
- Currently enrolled as a full-time student or accepted to a university other than the University of Hawaii at Manoa or Oregon State University.
- Transcripts from all high schools, community colleges and universities attended.
- Personal statement.

Application Deadline:

Completed application and attachments must be postmarked by May 1 for the Fall Semester.
