To enroll in Korean 101, 102, 201, or 202:

Register for CRL 101, 102, 201, or 202 with the following section numbers:

101 - Section 311: 10:00-10:50 AM, Mon-Fri

101 - Section 312: 12:00-12:50 PM, Mon-Fri

101 - Section 313: 3:00-3:50 PM, Mon-Fri

102 - Section 311: 9:00-9:50 AM, Mon-Fri

102 - Section 312: 11:00-11:50 AM, Mon-Fri

201 - Section 311: 12:00-12:50 PM, Mon-Fri

202 - Section 311: 1:00-1:50 PM, Mon-Fri

For all other levels (297A, 301, 302, 397A, 497A):

Register for CRL XXX-311

(where XXX is the level and 311 designates the section number for Korean)

For example: To enroll in Korean 302, sign up for CRL 302-311.

For levels 297A and higher, courses are scheduled around your availability

There is a \$360 supplementary fee for all levels.
