

Fall 2020 Course Types for Main Campus

THE FOUR COURSE FORMATS

IN-PERSON
Students and instructors all attend class in person with enhanced health protections, including wearing face coverings and decreasing classroom density.

FLEX IN-PERSON
Students participate in a mix of in-person and online modes. For example, you may be in a rotating group that alternates between in-person and online meetings following the weekly class schedule. Or you may participate in lectures online and labs in person. The exact mix of in-person and online will be determined by your instructor.

LIVE ONLINE
The instructor and students are online simultaneously, and your instructor provides content in a live online platform.

ICOURSE
For the majority of coursework, students and instructors are not required to be online simultaneously, and students complete their work through D2L.

Travel to the U.S.

If you require a new visa, most U.S. embassies have limited visa processing services.

The following countries and regions have travel restrictions to the U.S.

- China
- Iran
- European Schengen Area **
- Ireland and United Kingdom
- Brazil
- Canada and Mexico – essential travel only

In Transit or Stop Overs – will this restrict people from enter the USA. Stacey Coulthard said for In Transit it does count. People should plan to by pass those listed countries to avoid complications with entering the USA.

- SEVIS and new I-20 would need to be issued.
- If student changes to Global Campus they will have to cancel the SEVIS and when they want to return to main campus be issued a new one and have a new I-20 completed.

STUDENT QUESTIONS:

- If a student wants to take a gap year they will have to terminate the current SEVIS and then reapply. They have to wait 2 semesters for the SEVIS benefits.
 - If this is a route a student wants to go they will have to pay I-9 fee again.
 - Student qualify for Back2UA program if they are in good academic standing.
 - ISS will provide the documentation for students if they decide to take a leave in Fall 2020.
- Grad Level Students
 - Leave of Absence paperwork needs to be submitted by the student.
 - ISS can assist.
