Re: Academic Eligibility Appeals Process

A new [Academic Eligibility policy](#) was approved in May 2019 and came into effect in the Fall 2019 semester. Due to COVID-19 and the [Revised Academic Eligibility and Grading Policies in Spring 2020](#), the Fall 2020 semester will be the first in which students may earn **Ineligible Status**.

Students who become ineligible after the Fall 2020 term must appeal to be eligible to remain in, or to enroll in, classes at the university. Students whose appeals are approved will be granted another term of Probation status. **The submission of an appeal does not guarantee the appeal will be approved.**

**Since queries on Academic Eligibility within UAccess Student provide a snapshot of a student's academic record, it is essential that grades are submitted by the semester deadline so that advisors are best able to support our students with their academic eligibility questions.**
