

# New Features of Zoom August 16, 2023

## Q&A

Does this get added to the student D2L calendar?

Yes, any Zoom meeting created within D2L will be added to the course calendar.

Will it also push to the students CatCloud?

I do not believe so but I can't say for certain. I'm not sure where CatCloud is pulling from. If it pulls directly from D2L course calendars, yes. If not, no. Sorry that isn't more helpful but I'll see if I can find out for sure. CatCloud says it integrates with D2L but doesn't say explicitly that all calendar items will copy over. I'm reaching out to the Trellis team for more info.

Unrelated to this presentation — I cannot disable Closed Captioning and it is very distracting when I am presenting. I tried every hint and direction. Any advice?

If you are not using D2L, then all your participants would need to be logged on to the Zoom session, correct? Also, can you import a CSV with non-UA email accounts? Thanks.

This will depend on how the meeting is set up. When scheduling a meeting, you can choose to require UA authentication, or not. Details on importing a CSV of registrants can be found here.

Do recordings in Zoom have the same retention as Zoom in Panopto?

No, they do not. Zoom recordings are only accessible within Zoom for 130 days. Panopto content will remain indefinitely although it will be "archived" if it has not been viewed for 13 months. Once archived, it can be unarchived with a single click but it will take 24-48 hours to become available. To clarify, all Zoom cloud recordings get sent to Panopto automatically. You don't need to do anything extra for them to be sent to Panopto.

For the Zoom and D2L portion. If we have TA's Can our TA's add their office hours into D2L/Zoom as well?

Yes absolutely, as long as they schedule it within the D2L course, it will populate the calendar. If they create it outside of the course, they can create a recurring meeting on the D2L course calendar and manually add the link. This method is often used when an instructor uses the same office hours for multiple courses.

Where the Raise Hand is on the tool bar I see a setting for "play chime for raised hands." Does that mean I'll hear a chime when others raise their hand?

That is correct. I believe it is the same chime sound that plays when someone joins a meeting (assuming the meeting has that chime enabled)

Within the COM, when we schedule meetings through Outlook, Microsoft Teams automatically populates. Since we only use zoom in our area, is there a way to disable Microsoft Teams?

1. In Outlook, choose **File** and then **Options**.
2. Select the **Add-ins** tab of Outlook Options dialog box.
3. Confirm that Microsoft Teams Meeting Add-in for Microsoft Office is listed in the Active Application Add-ins list
4. If the Teams Meeting Add-in is listed in the Active Application Add-ins list, select **Disabled Items** in Manage and then select **Go...**
5. Set the **checkbox** next to Microsoft Teams Meeting Add-in for Microsoft Office.
6. Choose **OK** on all dialog boxes and restart Outlook.

Where is the Security tab to suspend participants?

Only hosts/co-hosts will see the Security icon in the meeting toolbar. It will appear to the left of the Participants icon.
