Please note, this is not a complete list of every event offered in the state. A few ideas popped into my mind today and I'm always happy to add more.

- Arizona Department of Agriculture's Annual Recertification Events for PMD/OPM (each Spring) and Agriculture (each December) in various towns. All certified applicators and Pest Control Advisors will receive a course flyer with dates and locations with their annual renewal notices.
- Southwest Horticulture Annual Day of Education (SHADE), hosted by the Arizona Nursery Association. Historically in Glendale, Arizona in August. PMD/OPM and Ag. Visit their website <https://azna.org/> to stay in the loop.
- Annual Desert Agricultural Conference. Ag CEUs only. The 2026 conference will be in Maricopa in late April. Search the Arizona Nursery Association's <https://azna.org/> or the Arizona Crop Protection Association's <https://azcropprotection.com/> websites for updates and registration announcements.
- The Arizona Community Tree Council offers a variety of events throughout the year, several offering CEUs. Search their website <https://www.aztrees.org/> for details or to request to be added to their listserv.
