NOMINATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Committee on Elections is conducting the Spring 2012 Primary Faculty Election in accordance with the Constitution and Bylaws of the General Faculty of The University of Arizona.

- 1. Nominating petitions will be available online (http://facultygovernance.arizona.edu/faculty_elections) or at the Faculty Center through the close of business on Monday, February 13, 2012.
- 2. Completed nominating petitions must be returned to the Faculty Center, 1216 E. Mabel St. (PO Box 210456), by Monday, February 13, 2012.
- 3. Nominees are requested to submit a statement not to exceed 150 words with their completed petitions, describing their reasons for seeking office. These statements will be used for publicity purposes and are available on the election website with the announcement of the online election.
- 4. Only members of the General Faculty may be nominated, or nominate themselves, for Chair of the Faculty, Vice Chair of the Faculty, Secretary of the Faculty, College Representative seats on the Faculty Senate, the Committee of Eleven, the Committee on Committees, or the elected faculty portion of the Strategic Planning and Budget Advisory Committee (SPBAC).
- 5. The person being nominated must sign the consent line in order for the nominating petition to be valid.
- 6. Only signatures of members of the General (Voting) Faculty are valid on nominating petitions.
- 7. No fewer than twenty signatures are required on petitions for Committee of Eleven, Committee on Committees, or the Strategic Planning and Budget Advisory Committee (SPBAC). No fewer than forty signatures are required for Chair of the Faculty. Vice Chair of the Faculty or Secretary of the Faculty petitions. The number of valid signatures required for nomination as Faculty Senate College Representative is not less than 10% of the members of their College Faculty, with a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 20, as listed below:

The terms for five of the seats on the Committee of Eleven shall end 5/31/14. The term for Committee on Committees shall end 5/31/15.
