Laura Lunsford, PhD

Professor and Chair of Psychology at Campbell University

Lunsford is an expert in mentoring and leadership development. She has authored over 40 peer-reviewed articles, chapters, and books on these topics. She was a tenured Associate Professor at the University of Arizona and served as the Director of: UNCW's Executive Education Center; the Park Scholarships at NC State; and of Alumni Relations at Duke University's Fuqua School of Business. A board member of the International Mentoring Association, she co-authored the recent National Academies Consensus Study on the Science of Effective Mentorship, and is on the editorial board of the International Journal of Mentoring and Coaching in Education. Her B.A. and Ph.D are from NC State and her M.S. is from UNC-Greensboro.
