Dr. Kraus serves on the board of the directors for the Association on Higher Education and Disability (AHEAD) and has had the privilege of delivering keynotes at campuses such as Singapore Management University, Duke University, and Wake Forest University. Outside of work, she is an avid wheelchair tennis player and was recently recognized as one of Tucson's Top 40 Under 40.
