## **ALVSCE Golf Cart General Procedures and Safety**

- Unit leaders are expected to remove cart privileges for those drivers who violate guidelines or otherwise put themselves or others in danger.
- Drivers must be at least 18-years old and have a minimum of 2-years of licensed driving experience and possess a valid driver's license.
- Completion of **BOTH** UA's defensive driving course and UA's utility cart training class are required prior to allowance of hand's on training.
- Completion of hand's on training, <u>and documentation</u> of hand's on training, are required for each utility cart an employee will be driving.
- Each unit should designate 1 or 2 people who are authorized to train other operators for the carts that they manage and maintain.
- Drivers must re-certify for each of the above trainings every 4 years.
- Driver and <u>ALL</u> passengers must wear seatbelts. Drivers may only carry as many passengers as they have seatbelts for. Unit owners must install seatbelts if currently absent.
- Drivers must perform a pre-trip safety inspection prior to operating the vehicle<sup>i</sup>.
- Carts are <u>not</u> allowed on major high traffic roadways such as Speedway, Campbell, 6<sup>th</sup> Street, and Euclid. In addition, there are several areas on campus where utility carts are prohibited from both driving on and parking. Drivers must be aware of these areas<sup>ii</sup>.
- Drivers may not talk or text on cell phones, listen to music, or eat or drink while operating the vehicle.
- Utility carts are subject to the same rules as other motor vehicles and must always obey traffic control signs.
- An annual safety inspection must be performed by University Motor Pool mechanics or an authorized delegate on all licensed vehicles (including utility carts), as found in <a href="Appendix A">Appendix A</a> of the Fleet Safety Policy.
