As we are now coming up on a full week of remote instruction, we want to discuss our campus polling solution, TurningPoint, and how it can be used when you are teaching remotely. Contrary to what you may think or have heard, TurningPoint can be used in a strictly remote or online environment for both synchronous and asynchronous polling.

Turning Technologies, the company behind TurningPoint, has offered their web product free to instructors and students to use until July 1. During this challenging time, you have had to quickly adapt to remote instruction. TurningPoint is another tool that can support and enhance your virtual and remote learning environment. It can help you to engage remote students with real-time formative assessment, in-the-moment polling and to schedule questions and content for completion outside of class meeting times.
