The Office of the Vice President for Research is accepting pre-proposals for the NSF Graduate STEM Fellows in K-12 Education (GK-12) program. The guidelines for the program can be found at <http://www.nsf.gov/pubs/2009/nsf09549/nsf09549.htm>. An institution may submit no more than one proposal. The letter of intent (required) is due on April 20, 2010 and the full proposal is due at NSF on June 3, 2010.

All pre-proposals should be ranked by the Dean of each college and submitted to this office by **Friday, March 19, 2010**. The pre-proposal should consist of:

- (1) no more than a two-page summary of the proposed program
- (2) short curriculum vitae.

If more than one is received, a committee of peers will be convened to select the University's candidates.
