



















- ▶ POSITION TITLE, SALARY, AND DESCRIPTION: Tenured, academic year, faculty position (with possible additional compensation during summer contingent on the budget) will begin preferably in Fall Quarter 2012, to serve as Chair of the Plant Sciences Department and as teaching faculty. The Plant Science Department currently includes three majors: Plant Science, Agriculture Science and Agribusiness Management. The Chair must be a leader with interdisciplinary thinking and will help guide faculty and staff to achieve a shared vision for the department. The Chair will be an effective communicator and have the ability to provide exceptional leadership in advancing the visibility and strategic vision of the department. Responsibilities include managing and mentoring faculty and staff; curriculum development; course scheduling, hiring lecturers, advising students; developing and managing budgets; overseeing the Advisory Board, serving as liaison to industry; serving on department, college, and university committees; participating in all department activities; engaging in professional activities. Teaching will be expected in area of expertise. The applicant will also be expected to stay current in his/her field and integrate related materials into teaching and scholarly activities. Salary and rank are competitive and dependent on qualifications and experience. An applicant whose work incorporates a global perspective and a commitment to diversity in higher education is particularly encouraged to apply.
