

2012 Student Technology Innovation Award

The Student Technology Innovation Award recognizes University of Arizona students who have excelled in a technology related internship, independent study, or research project. This can be the result of contributing to the development of a new technology, research that enhances an existing technology or work that contributes to the commercialization of a new technology. The student needs to demonstrate active participation in the project. The project should exhibit a high level of innovation and ideally have commercial application potential.

Criteria:

The award is open to both graduate and undergraduate students who are currently enrolled at the University and actively pursuing a degree. The work or internship, independent study or research project must have been completed sometime during January 2011 and December 2011. Students must be nominated by a faculty advisor/mentor and be in good academic standing (3.0 or better GPA). A faculty/advisor signature is required to certify academic standing.

Nomination Procedure:

To apply, a completed nomination form is required as well as at least one and up to three letters of recommendation from either faculty members or direct supervisors from the internship or research experience who are familiar with the student's work.

A committee consisting of University of Arizona faculty, staff and Tucson business leadership will review the nominations and select the award recipient. All applications once submitted will not be returned.

Winners:

One student will be selected for this award. He or she will be notified prior to the Technology Innovation Awards Luncheon, at Innovation Day at the UA on Tuesday, March 6, 2012. The recipient will be presented their award at the luncheon, which includes a \$1,000 scholarship to be deposited in his or her Bursar account.

Nomination Process:
