The Lífe & Career of Jane Sílverthorne

Jane was born in Somerset, England on July 26, 1953. Her talent and passion for science began early in life and led to a BSc from the University of Sussex and a Ph.D. from the the University of Warwick. Following postdoctoral research at UCLA, Jane joined the faculty and rose through the ranks as professor at UC-Santa Cruz. In 1998, Jane joined the NSF and transformed plant biology through her leadership in the Plant Genome Research Program. For over a decade, Jane served as a highly respected senior executive leader at NSF until her retirement in 2017, when her commitment to plant biology continued through her engagement with the SoAR Foundation, the Boyce Thompson Institute, and the American Society of Plant Biology.

Jane is remembered for her influential scientific work on light-regulated gene expression in plants and by her pioneering exploration of the evolutionary diversity of photoregulation. Jane brought to the NSF a broad and deep scientific knowledge. She had an unwavering commitment to promoting the impact of science, and she was a tireless advocate for broadening participation in the scientific enterprise. Jane's advocacy for early career scientists helped to launch the careers of many scientists, educators, and leaders in plant biology today.

We remember Jane as a devoted mentor, colleague, and friend, a person of many talents. She was an avid reader, deep thinker, with a passion for art as much as science, and she committed to the best outcomes in all of her endeavors. We celebrate Jane today with memories of her enduring spirit and we honor her legacy.


