









Students needing support with basic needs need assistance with paying for essential services (health care, mental health care, academic support) the most, followed by housing, food, and transportation.


Students anticipate needing the most support around financing their educational journey and advocating for themselves.

SENSE OF Belonging

95% of incoming CALES students are excited to be a student at the University of Arizona and **82%** believe they will find a sense of community at UArizona. **Nearly 90%** of students expect that staff and faculty are here to help them be successful and **2/3rds** believe that other students will assist them if they need help.
