BUDGET PRESENTATION: SPECIAL GUEST – JANIS RUTHERFORD (50 MINS)

- Business retreats and town halls are held multiple times a year. Attend to ask questions and hear the latest announcements.
- Q&A session proceeded.
- No additional information has been provided aside from the ABOR meetings.
- Deficit is not solely due to change in budget model. College has been experiencing a deficit for the past few years. Expenses have been higher than revenue.
- ❖ 3 years ago, the deficit was 3 million. Last year's deficit was 6 million. This year's deficit is 10 million.
- The faculty feels they have not been made aware of these deficits until recently and request better communication.
- Director position is crucial to SPLS, and the freeze is detrimental to the search.
- Betsy Arnold proposes to request hiring exception for Director role and plans to lead the initiative. The exception must be in writing per Janis.
- Dean Burgess influences must be directed to him.
- Janis encourages faculty to be vocal about the hiring exception, as well as with any growth and/or cost-saving ideas. (i.e. How to expand Yuma and Maricopa projects? Legacy degrees? Enrollment growth? Course design?)
- Concern about start-up fund policy. As of now, this policy has not changed.
- Reminder that financial information is made available online and you can work with Leslie to retrieve these prepopulated reports down to the account.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND FACULTY MEETINGS?

- Who is considered "staff" needs to be defined.
- ❖ A Grad Student representative was proposed.
 - o What is the value in this?
 - An eye-opening experience for the grad students and serves as a different perspective for faculty.
 - The faculty feels if grad student relevant topics are being discussed, then the representative should be invited. Otherwise, the grad student representative should not be present.
- Other meetings can be set up outside of faculty meeting such as a "State of the School" meeting, so that the space can be maintained for faculty.
