- or a one-one interview

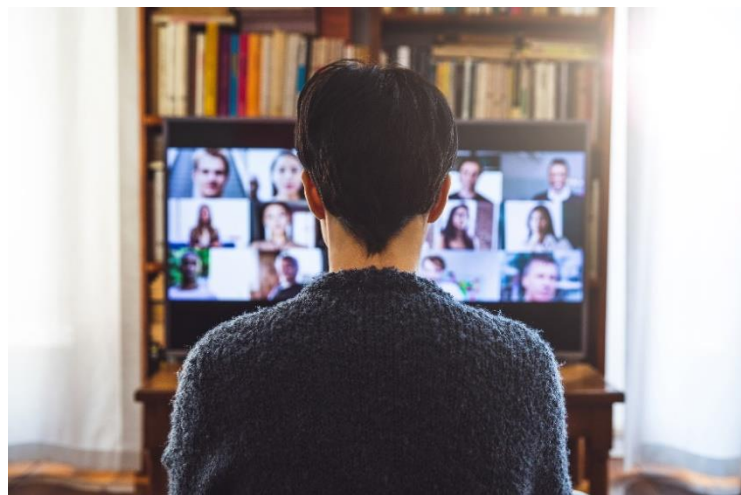
Participants will receive:
