- 1. Name of nominee, nominator, and advisor
- 2. Title and description of scholarly work
- 3. Copy of scholarly work
- 4. Letter describing the impact of the scholarly work, provided by nominator

What is the selection procedure?

Members of the SPLS Graduate Student Program Committee will select the recipient based on review of nominations submitted to the Director of Graduate Studies, Dr. Betsy Arnold (<u>barnoldaz@gmail.com</u>). This award may not be presented every year.
