

## **SCHOOL OF PLANT SCIENCES AWARD FOR OUTSTANDING SCHOLARLY ACHIEVEMENT BY A STUDENT**

The ***School of Plant Sciences Award for Outstanding Scholarly Achievement by a Student*** recognizes an outstanding original contribution to the body of scientific knowledge by a current graduate student in SPLS.

### ***Who can be nominated?***

Any student who is enrolled the School of Plant Sciences in the current academic year.

### ***Who can nominate?***

Nominations may be made by any faculty member in the School of Plant Sciences.

### ***How is a student nominated?***

Nominations must be assembled carefully and completely, and should include:

1. Name of nominee, nominator, and advisor
2. Title and description of scholarly work
3. Copy of scholarly work
4. Letter describing the impact of the scholarly work, provided by nominator

### ***What is the selection procedure?***

Members of the SPLS Graduate Student Program Committee will select the recipient based on review of nominations submitted to the Director of Graduate Studies, Dr. Betsy Arnold ([barnoldaz@gmail.com](mailto:barnoldaz@gmail.com)). This award may not be presented every year.
