

SCHOOL OF PLANT SCIENCES AWARD FOR OUTSTANDING SERVICE AS A TEACHING ASSISTANT

The ***School of Plant Sciences Award for Outstanding Service as a Teaching Assistant*** recognizes a graduate student for particularly outstanding service as a teaching assistant in a course taught by an SPLS faculty member.

Who can be nominated?

Any student who has served as a teaching assistant in a course taught by a faculty member in the School of Plant Sciences in the current academic year.

Who can nominate?

Nominations may be made by any faculty member in the School of Plant Sciences who has taught a course with a TA during the past year.

How is a student nominated?

Nominations must be assembled carefully and completely, and should include:

1. Name of nominee and nominator
2. Course title and number, enrollment, and semester taught
3. Overview of student's activities as TA
4. Letter from nominator detailing the nature, impact, and lasting effects of the student's exemplary activities as a teaching assistant

What is the selection procedure?

Members of the SPLS Graduate Student Program Committee will select the recipient based on review of nominations submitted to the Director of Graduate Studies, Dr. Betsy Arnold (barnoldaz@gmail.com). This award may not be presented every year.
