PROGRAM DETAILS

- **WRITING WORKSHOPS**
Every Mon/Wed 9AM-11AM (U.S. Pacific Time)
- **WRITING BOOTCAMPS**
Every Mon/Wed 11 AM - 12 PM
- **FACILITATED TUTORING GROUPS**
Small groups of 3-4 students meet with GWI faculty for 2 hours/twice weekly (days/times vary)
- **INDIVIDUAL TUTORING**
Individual tutoring with GWI faculty member for 50 minutes/twice weekly (days/times vary)
