Subject: 2011 Summer Intern Program

The USGA Green Section is pleased to offer turfgrass management students the opportunity to travel on Turf Advisory Service visits with our regional agronomists for one week during the 2011 golfing season. We believe that traveling with our staff can broaden students' perspectives of the turfgrass industry, and the directions they take with their educational endeavors and career paths.

The internship is limited to one week, and may be done in conjunction with other summer internships. Participants receive a \$250 stipend, plus all documented expenses paid.

Attached is a description of the program that discusses how to proceed in nominating a candidate from your institution. The program is run on a regional basis, using the physical borders of each of the Green Section's eight regions. One or more students in each region may be selected to participate, depending on the number of agronomists in that region.

*Each university may nominate only one student.* During your selection process, keep in mind that the student will interact with many different people in a wide variety of situations. The student should have the ability to react well in these situations and do a good job representing your university.
