Position Description: The University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point is seeking a Papermaking and Laboratory Project Specialist for the Wisconsin Institute for Sustainable Technology (WIST). This is a 1.0 FTE position to carry out contract research and development on the University's pilot paper machine and associated laboratory equipment. The position requires hands-on experience of papermaking as well as a demonstrable track record in the performance and reporting of contract research and development projects. The position also requires experience and expertise in routine testing and analysis procedures. Whilst the work is predominantly laboratory and pilot paper machine based, the role holder is also expect to liaise with commercial clients and assist in the costing and pricing of projects. The position reports to the Director of Laboratory Services to meet WIST's goal of providing outreach research, testing, analytical and paper machine services to industry and other clients.

Department/University Description: The Wisconsin Institute for Sustainable Technology (WIST) at the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point is a program of the College of Natural Resources dedicated to developing renewable materials and energy technologies for sustainable economic development.
