

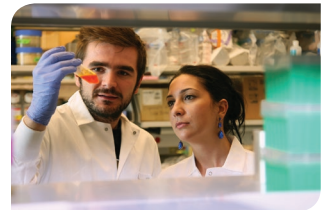
# Earn as you learn: Be a TGen Helios Scholar

Helios Scholars at TGen is a paid summer internship program in biomedical research at the Translational Genomics Research Institute (TGen). Interns work full-time on a research project under the mentorship of a TGen scientist to unravel the genetic components of diabetes, neurological disease, pathogens and cancer.

As a part of the comprehensive program, Helios Scholars also: attend seminars to boost their professional skills, explore possible STEM career paths, practice scientific writing, present their research, attend social and networking events, and create a scientific poster. The program capstone is a formal symposium where interns present their research results.
