Directions

From Interstate 10

Exit at the Congress/Broadway exit.

Travel East on Broadway approximately 1.5 miles.

Turn right on Church Ave.

The Tucson Convention Center Parking Lot A is located on the right side of the street before you reach Cushing St.

From East Tucson

Travel west on Broadway.

As you approach downtown stay in the left-hand lane and merge onto Congress St.

Travel West on Congress approximately 1.5 miles.

Turn left on Church Ave.

Proceed south, crossing Broadway Blvd.

The Tucson Convention Center Parking Lot A is located on the right side of the street before you reach Cushing St.

Parking

There are three designated parking lots around the Tucson Convention Center campus. In addition to these three lots, there are several other parking lots and parking structures close to the Tucson Convention Center campus.

Parking Lot A (250 spaces) is located off Church Ave., between Congress and Cushing St. on the West side of the street.

Parking Lot B (500 spaces) is located off Granada between Congress and Cushing St. on the East side of the street.

Parking Lot C (200 spaces) is located off Granada between Congress and Cushing St. on the East side of the street.

Accessible Seating

TUCSON ARENA:

Accessible seating is available in all venues. On the Concourse level of the Tucson Arena, (*which is accessible by way of the main Breezeway entrance,*) accessible seating (total of 34 seats) is located on the North, East and West sides of the facility. The seat to the right or left of the accessible seat area will be a "companion" seat. Larger family groups accompanying disabled guests will be assisted to nearby seating.

Additional accessible seating (*total of 50*) and companion seating (total of 50) are located on the Tucson Arena Floor. Larger family groups accompanying disabled guests will be assisted to nearby seating. You can reach the Tucson Arena floor by way of the main Breezeway. Opposite the Arena entry, enter the Meeting Rooms/North Exhibit Hall doors, take the elevator to the Lower Level and take a left to the Tucson Arena.

In the Orchestra Level of the Tucson Music Hall there are (16) accessible seats with (16) companion seats.

Accessible Parking and drop off location for disabled guests

Parking Lot A (*250 spaces*) is located off Church Ave., between Congress and Cushing St. on the West side of the street. There are **44 accessible parking spaces** located on the North West side of the lot close to the Arena building. There will also be a drop off area in Parking Lot A that will remain available when the lot has filled. The drop off area provides the shortest walking distance to the event and is the best option if you don't have a disabled plate or placard for parking.

Parking Lot B (*500 spaces*) is located off Granada between Congress and Cushing St. on the East side of the street. There are **14 accessible parking spaces** located on the North side of the lot.

Parking Lot C (*200 spaces*) is located off Granada between Congress and Cushing St. on the East side of the street. There are **15 accessible parking space** located on the North East side of the lot.

Assisted Listening Devices

Tucson Arena has the capability of providing assisted listening devices to (100) guests. These devices can be checked out in the Administrative Office (*located across the Breezeway from the main Arena entrance.*) Guests are required to leave a valid driver's license or a government issued ID card.

Tucson Music Hall has the capability of providing assisted listening devices to (40) guests. These devices can be checked out in the Tucson Music Hall Lobby directly behind the Ticket Office. Guests are required to leave a valid driver's license or a government issued ID card.

Facility Information

No smoking inside all venues.

The doors will open to the public one-hour before the graduation. Visitors are encouraged to arrive at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start time and please allow additional time for traffic delays.

Baby carriages or child strollers can be checked-in at designated Administration Office.

No laser pointers or prohibited items allowed in venues.
