- 5) supervisor's name, phone number and email address for each work period listed and whether or not we may contact them for reference.

CURRENT TRANSCRIPT

An unofficial copy is sufficient with the application; however if selected, an official college transcript will be required.

VETERANS

Bring a copy of your DD214 and if applicable VA documentation.

PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

Bring a copy of your schedule A letter.

PEACE CORPS AMERICORPS

Bring a copy of your letter if within one year of Noncompetitive Eligibility.

USDA will also be accepting applications from Veterans, Persons with Disabilities (Schedule A) and former Peace Corps and AmeriCorps VISTAs.
