

Title: Undergraduate Researchers, Hurwitz Lab

Position Summary:

The Department of Agricultural & Biosystems Engineering at the University of Arizona invites applications for three undergraduate researchers in Dr. Bonnie Hurwitz's research group (www.hurwitzlab.org). The successful candidate will help develop "seed" content for a viral ecology community forum called VERVE Net to increase connectivity and knowledge dissemination in viral ecology research. The goal of the VERVE Net project is to provide an online forum to enable discussions about laboratory, field, and computational methods to increase connectivity and collaboration among virus ecology researchers.

Duties/Responsibilities:

Position is responsible for developing "seed" content for VERVE Net. This individual will work closely with the Program Coordinator to generate and solicit site specific content including: molecular and bioinformatics protocols, discussion forum topics, job postings, conference announcements, and "behind the article" postings for seeding the initial forum. The candidate will provide content support for VERVE Net.
