



The USA National Phenology Network (USA-NPN; [www.usanpn.org](http://www.usanpn.org)), in the UA School of Natural Resources and the Environment is looking for a sharp Junior, Senior, or 1<sup>st</sup> year Grad Student to help us with our Outreach and Education projects and programs. The USA-NPN facilitates the national citizen and professional science program called *Nature's Notebook*, [www.naturesnotebook.org](http://www.naturesnotebook.org), where people enter observations on plant and animal life cycle events to document seasonal and long term changes in their timing.

We'd like to hire someone who has an interest in science as well as someone who can creatively contribute to educational materials we are developing, however, the student need not be in a science degree program to apply. Specifically, some tasks for the job would be developing photo guides for identification (graphic design skills a plus!); videos and how-to tutorials that are engaging and encourage people to participate; content for social media for local and national audiences (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, Snapchat); and ideas for teaching people about the natural world.

The position is 10 hours a week, and the pay range is \$12 - \$14 an hour, depending upon experience. The job posting will close on August 31, 2016, at 5:00 pm.
