APPLICATION INFORMATION

Each year, the elite and highly competitive NVD Program accepts UA undergraduate and graduate students from all fields of study. We look for students who share a passion for creative problem solving and developing new ideas. There are no prerequisite classes required, but you should apply at a specific time in your studies (see below).

How long is the program?

The NVD Program is a full academic year. Students dive into the entrepreneurship experience in fall, and by the end of spring semester, teams have built a viable venture.

What do students learn in the NVD Program?

Our pioneering curriculum, hands-on mentoring, and unique collaborations empower students to develop a new way of thinking, a new way of learning and a new model for action.

How do students use entrepreneurship education?

WHEN TO APPLY

Undergraduate students: Apply during junior year to participate in the McGuire Program during senior year.

Master's students: Apply in the penultimate year of study to participate in the McGuire Program during the final year.

Doctoral students: Apply during any year of study.

The application is online. Finalists will be invited to interview.

Priority applications due Nov. 1, 2017. **Final applications due January 25, 2018.**
