Summary of the Mission Garden goal: Interpreting the agricultural history of the Tucson Basin.

There are multiple positions available *to fill*.

Internship Responsibilities:

Variety of garden and outreach tasks, ranging from watering, planting, biological eradication of weeds, harvesting, tree care and maintenance, educational programs, tours and interpretation

Specific tasks the student will carry out and any particular skills needed (horticultural skill, interpersonal skill – working with volunteers or the public, professional skills – scheduling, organization, punctuality etc.)

*There are no **specific skills** required. Individuals can take on specific responsibilities in accordance with their interests and abilities. For example, if they like gardening and working with children or individuals living with mental illness, they could participate in educational programs with these groups.*

Commitment and terms:

Hours- At least 3 hours per week at flexible times.

Duration of the internship will be at least one semester, but the internship term can be negotiated.

This is an unpaid internship, but students can **earn academic credit** for their work in consultation with their major advisor.
