MICHAEL BONINE MEMORIAL TRAVEL & RESEARCH AWARD

Award amount ranges from \$500-\$2000. Applications are **due on February 26th, 2018**

ELIGIBILITY:

Preference will be given to dedicated, curious, and ethical students motivated to learn about the world. In most cases the award supports summer travel. Preference will also be given to students who travel 'off-the-beaten path' and demonstrate financial need. Applicants do not need to be MENAS majors, and do not need to be US citizens.

UNDERGRADUATE APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

BY MONDAY, FEBRUARY 26 submit electronically via Scholarship Universe (<https://scholarshipuniverse.arizona.edu/susa/Default.aspx>)

- A personal statement that explains how the award will be important to your research or education. What difference will the award make to your proposed travel or research plans? If financial hardship is part of your justification, please explain (one page)
- A resume or curriculum vitae (maximum two pages)
- A copy of undergraduate transcripts (unofficial copies are acceptable)
- A letter of reference addressed to the 'Michael Bonine Memorial Travel and Research Award Committee'. For undergraduate students this letter could be from a professor, advisor or an employment supervisor. Names and contact information of recommenders will be entered in Scholarship Universe, which will contact them to request letters.

Recipients are expected to electronically submit a brief written and photographic summary of the endeavors supported by this award no later than 3 months after completion of the activity supported by the award. Descriptions and photos will be used to publicize the award.
