### Hands-on Experience

Hunnewell interns gain valuable experience in caring for and managing collections at a top-tier botanical institution, learning all aspects of plant collection stewardship and working alongside expert staff. Interns focus on one of four concentrations: horticulture, arboriculture, plant production, or curation.



### Collaborative Learning

While the program empowers participants to challenge themselves individually, it also fosters and values a sense of community and teamwork. Along with instructional classes led by Arboretum staff, interns help each other learn through peer collaboration and group projects.



### Exposure to the Field

The internship also includes outreach to experience professional horticulture more broadly, with field trips to other public gardens and enriching networking opportunities.
