# Application is Open!

The Carson Scholars Program is a one-year fellowship in the art of science communication. Carson Scholars have the opportunity to explore their motivations and science stories and develop meaningful and engaging ways in which to share their work with other researchers in their field and to non-specialist audiences as well.

Carson Scholars collaborate with their peers and the Carson faculty mentors, as well as participate in workshops and put their communication skills to work through presentations, op-eds and community outreach. Carson Scholars go on to secure more funding by way of scholarships and fellowships. Many scholars have also been able to secure faculty positions right after graduation.

Included in the fellowship is a \$5,000 graduate scholarship to graduate students committed to interdisciplinary research on environment and society. The scholarships are designed to support and retain UA graduate students whose research is related to the environment and/or its intersection with social justice and who are interested in communicating science to a broad audience.

Current UA PhD students, UA JD students or UA master's students in terminal master's creative or professional programs are eligible to apply.
