Internship Description

The 2021-2022 BIO5 Ambassador Internship is a unique two semester opportunity offered by the BIO5 Institute that will allow undergraduate students from all majors to earn 2 internship credits through The A Center (TLS 393/493) or their major. Interns will:

- Learn strategies for science communications
