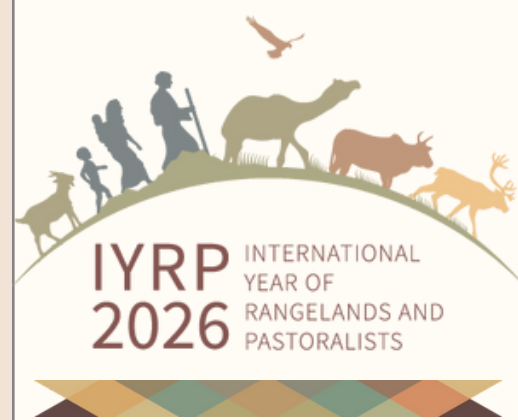


GRASS-RANGELAND ARTS BASED EDUCATION WEBINAR SERIES
