

# **SUMMER JOB OPPORTUNITY**

The Medicine Bow-Routt National Forests ([www.fs.fed.us/r2/mbr](http://www.fs.fed.us/r2/mbr)), Laramie Ranger District, is looking for up to two summer employees interested in being part of the district **range and weeds crew in 2013**. Duty station location is Laramie, WY.

**Work Schedule and Salary/Benefits:** One position will be filled at the GS-5 (\$15.00/hr) level and the other at the GS-4 (\$13.41/hr) level. These positions can be filled from either announcement number at the 4 or 5 level. Both positions are eligible to earn 4 hours of sick and annual leave every two weeks (per pay period). Work schedule is full-time (80 hours/pay period). Government housing availability is limited. The GS-5 candidate would begin part-time work in mid March to early April and then convert to full-time in May and work until early November, depending on budget. The GS-4 candidate would begin work in May and work through late August.

**Duties** for both positions will vary from grazing allotment inspections and range monitoring to noxious weed treatment and inventory surveys. Specific projects may involve fixing or building fences, working with partners or permittees to construct spring developments, using saddle stock to assess range conditions on wilderness allotments, or staying overnight at remote locations. This work requires technical ability in plant identification and using herbicide application equipment. Training will be provided. The work may be arduous due to rough terrain and adverse weather conditions. Employees must have a valid driver's license, be able to safely operate a standard transmission vehicle, ATV/UTV, and be able to hike up to five miles with a 25-30 lb pack. Opportunities to assist other resource programs, e.g., fire, timber and wildlife, also exist.
