## VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT

TO: All Interested Parties

SUBJECT: Recruiting Wildlife Specialist for Davie County, North Carolina.

The North Carolina Wildlife Services program is recruiting for a Wildlife Specialist (Biological Science Technician) for work on a cooperatively funded project. The assignment involves the performance of a wide range of duties related to management of wildlife damage, but primary duties will be alleviating beaver damage problems in Davie, Yadkin, Surry, Stokes, and Forsyth counties in North Carolina.

The assignment involves working closely with private landowners and state, county, and federal officials in developing and conducting wildlife damage management activities. Trapping and removing beavers and other wildlife is an important part of the program. Effective communication skills are required and contacts with the public will be through meetings, workshops, and individual contacts. Ability to use e-mail and other computer-based functions is essential. Preference will be given to individuals with beaver damage management experience who currently hold or are currently pursuing a degree in wildlife or natural resources.

The position will be a GS-0404-3/4/5 (salary range \$24,933 - \$40,706), 13-month term appointment that may be extended up to 4 years. This position is eligible for health benefits and accrual of annual and sick leave. Starting dates are negotiable but prefer start by June 16, 2013. The successful candidate will be responsible for any associated moving costs.

- Must be a U.S. Citizen
- Must be 18 years old or older
- Valid state driver's license required at time of hiring
- Must be able to legally possess and use firearms

The successful candidate must pass a drug test prior to employment and must also certify that they have never been convicted of misdemeanor domestic violence (Lautenberg Amendment).

The duty station will be within Davie County, NC. A government vehicle will be assigned and all relevant equipment supplied.
