Attached, please find a job announcement for a Range Scientist, Assistant Professor at the Range Cattle Research and Education Center, University of Florida. Research and Education programs aimed at improving the economic and environmental sustainability of Florida rangelands continues to grow in importance among our clientele. This position has been identified as an essential component of our current faculty team, which includes expertise in forages, invasive weeds, soil and water science, and beef cattle production.
