
The Medicine Bow-Routt National Forests and Thunder Basin National Grassland (www.fs.usda.gov/mbr) are looking for summer employees interested in watershed management to work from May/June through August/September 2014. One or more positions may be filled at the GS-4 (~\$11.75/hr) to GS-7 (~\$16.28/hr) levels in Steamboat Springs, Colorado and Saratoga, Wyoming. This is a great opportunity to spend a summer in the field and learn about the US Forest Service's role in watershed management.



Job duties include a diverse range of surveys, inventory, monitoring, and restoration work. These positions include both field and office work. Work requires the ability to hike, wade, lift, carry and use equipment in rugged terrain and in mountain weather while collecting physical and biological data. The ability to work safely and work well in a team environment is necessary, including the ability to enjoy living in remote mountain or grassland settings. Prior watershed management experience is beneficial, but not required. A valid driver's license is required, and overnight travel to different locations on the Forest may also be required. Crews may periodically camp out overnight during the week, depending on work location. Limited government housing may be available for about \$5/day. Pets are prohibited in government housing and on the job.

These positions will be advertised on USAJOBS (www.usajobs.gov) for a short period between January and March 2014. If interested in applying, please follow these steps:
