



## 2015-2016 UNIVERSITY OF ARIZONA SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Thank you for your interest in the Southern Arizona Environmental Management Society (SAEMS) scholarships in support of environmental and related fields of study. Applications accepted after final December 2014 grades posted, and should be returned by March 2, 2015 to be considered for a scholarship award ranging between \$500 and \$4,000 (\$10,000 total available).

Finalists will be selected for interviews to be held in April 2015, with awards determined by the Scholarship Committee shortly after the interview process. Scholarship winners also receive a SAEMS 1-year student membership and luncheon ticket to introduce themselves to the SAEMS membership. Scholarship awards split evenly between Fall/Spring semesters except \$500 RTTP.

To be eligible you must:

- Plan on pursuing a career in the environmental arena;
  - Currently be a full-time University of Arizona undergraduate or graduate student
  - Have 2.5+ GPA & satisfactory degree progress (12 undergrad, or 3-9 grad units as applicable)
  - Continue for the 2015-2016 academic year at the University of Arizona (non-transferable)
