Great Basin Institute Field Season Positions Announcement 2015



BLM Hydrologist, Winnemucca, NV. Be part of an interdisciplinary team to support development of a comprehensive Environmental Analysis. (One-year appointment beginning immediately). Compensation: \$23.00/hour.

BLM Vegetation and ES&R Monitoring Technicians and Leads, Winnemucca, NV Susanville, CA and Boise. ID.

(March 16, 2015 for 26-weeks for Winnemucca and April 2015 – September 2015 for Susanville and Kanab). Help the BLM with post-wildfire Emergency Stabilization and Rehabilitation (ES&R), fuels, and weeds projects. Compensation: \$15.25/hour for Winnemucca, \$15.00/hour for Techs in Susanville and Kanab, \$18.59/hour for Leads.



BLM Seeds of Success Native Seed Collection Specialist, Winnemucca, NV and Moab, UT. Manage both field and office components of the SOS Seed Collection/Native Plant Program on behalf of the BLM. (April 13, 2015 for 27-weeks in Winnemucca, NV and April 6, 2015 for 34-weeks in Moab, UT). Compensation: \$17.00/hour.

BLM Minerals Resource Monitoring Technician, Winnemucca, NV. (28-week appointment beginning in March 2015) Inspect and document expired notice sites (proposals that disturbed less than 5 acres). Compensation: \$18.50/hour.

BLM Mountain-Bike Trail Environmental Assessment Associate, Ely, NV. Generate an Environmental Assessment for a proposed mountain-bike trail in Lincoln County, NV. (27-week appointment beginning in April 2015). Compensation: \$18.50/hour.

BLM Land Health Assessment District Leads, Elko and Ely, NV. Perform land health assessments through inventory and monitoring of sage-grouse habitat on NV public range lands and riparian systems within the BLM Elko district. (March 2, 2015 – November 20, 2015). Compensation: \$1,400 bi-weekly salary.

BLM Land Health Assessment Data Specialist, Reno, NV. Ensure the maintenance and integrity of the dataset, a high level of quality assurance and control (QA/QC), and data analysis and interpretation for the data collected on sage-grouse habitat. (February 2015 – November 2015). Compensation: \$1,400 bi-weekly.

BLM Upland Range and Drought Monitoring Technicians, Battle Mountain, NV. Characterize current riparian-wetland condition/functionality and implement a variety of upland monitoring protocols across public lands in support of drought management decisions and/or rangeland health evaluations. (26-week position starting in May 2015). Compensation: \$16.00/hour.

BLM Recreation Technician, Battle Mountain, NV. Assist with land management as it relates to recreation and visitor services. (26-week position starting in April 2015). Compensation: \$16.00/hour.

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BLM Natural Resource Data Specialist/Geospatial Analyst, Reno, NV. Assist in the organization, management and presentation of natural resource and spatial data in support of the Great Basin Landscape Conservation Cooperative (GBLCC). (February 2015 – February 2016). Compensation: \$22.74/hour.

BLM AIM Vegetation Monitoring Field Technicians and Leads, Susanville, CA, Palm Springs, CA, Kanab, UT, Spokane, WA and Lander, WY. Characterize vegetation using the Assessment, Inventory and Monitoring (AIM) protocol to inform decisions regarding solar energy installations and other land management issues. (February 2015 – April 2015 for Palm Springs, April-October in Susanville, CA, May-July in Kanab, UT, and starting in April in Spokane, WA, and Lander, WY). Compensation varies by location and position.

BLM Weed and Shrub Monitoring Technicians, Boise, ID. Support the BLM's post-wildfire Emergency Stabilization and Rehabilitation projects across the region through monitoring for noxious and invasive weeds, aerial seeding shrub density monitoring, and shrub seedling survival monitoring. (April 2015 – August 2015). Compensation: \$17.00-\$19.00/hour.

BLM GIS Technician, Needles, CA. Provide geographic information system (GIS) mapping and data analysis support related to conservation, restoration, transportation management and other natural resource management projects. (February – June, 2015). Compensation: \$19.00/hour

USFWS and Clark County, NV Field Crew Supervisors and Telemetry Technicians for the Desert Tortoise Line Distance Sampling Program, Las Vegas, NV. Desert tortoise monitoring will assist researchers in estimating population density and in monitoring translocation sites for this endangered species. (March 15, 2015 – May 2015). Compensation: \$1,368 bi-weekly salary for Supervisors and \$14.00/hours for Telemetry Techs.

USFWS and Clark County Technical Support Specialist (Data QA/QC and GIS), Las Vegas, NV. Data quality assurance/quality control (QA/QC) and database management and delivery. The Technical Support Specialist will focus on QA/QC of field data, and will play a key role in ensuring the effective and efficient collection and delivery of monitoring data. (March 2, 2015-June 26, 2015). Compensation: \$1,520.00 bi-weekly salary.

USFWS Restoration Coordinator, Desert National Wildlife Refuge (Clark County, NV). Facilitate and participate in the ecological restoration of sensitive wetland, riparian, and desert habitat. (March 2015 - December 2015). Compensation: \$17.00/hour.

Perform detailed vegetation and site data collection within population management units of the genetically distinct Bi-State Sage Grouse located along the western Nevada border where habitat restoration projects will be undertaken or are currently underway. (April 13, 2015 – August 14, 2015). Compensation: \$1,392.00 bi-weekly salary.
