

INTERN AT ALDERSPRING RANCH

Application deadline: March 12, 2018. Position Dates Flexible (May 1-September 15). 90 Day Commitment.

In partnership with the Central Idaho Rangelands Network, we are looking for interns with integrity and a passion for learning.

The Ranch: includes a 1000-acre ranch headquarters and 70 square miles of remote rangeland in Central Idaho. Alderspring Ranch has produced exceptional grass fed organic beef for nearly a quarter century.

The Project: Interns will participate in a 5-year-long conservation pilot project using herding techniques to reduce livestock & predator conflicts, restore rangeland ecosystems, and produce exceptional grassfed beef.

The Position: includes long days herding cattle on horseback, horse packing, backcountry camping, maintaining herd health, some hand weed control, and rangeland monitoring.

The Person: Tenacious, physically fit, independent, eager to learn, humble/teachable, hardworking, determined, calm under pressure, honest, and tough. Experience and education is not necessary but will be considered.

Compensation: DOE and references. Stipends range from \$900/month - \$1200/month. Housing (and some board) is provided.
