Poster Guidelines

- Poster size should be 48" X 36" in landscape orientation
- Poster must be posted by 7 am, Thursday, January 23, 2019

Oral Presentation Guidelines

- Presentations on Friday, January 24 between 8 am-Noon
- Presentations between 20 and 45 minutes

Review Criteria

Submissions will be evaluated on the following criteria:

1. **Relevance:** Provides sound and credible approaches, information, and discussion relevant to your respective field of study.
2. **Clarity:** Provides a clear focus. It defines a concept, approach or topic area and includes clearly defined goals, objectives and expected outcomes.
3. **Scientific Strength:** Provides science-based information for your respective field of study. Best available science, established methods and best practices are described clearly.
4. **Audience Engagement:** Information being presented should capture the attention of the audience in a creative way.
