

CONSERVATION RANGE RIDER INTERNSHIPS AT *Alderspring Ranch*

POSITION DATES: MAY 10TH (OR MAY 17TH) TO JULY 31ST.

THE RANCH: Includes a 1650-acre ranch headquarters and 70 square miles of remote rangeland in central Idaho. Alderspring Ranch has been growing grass fed organic beef for over 25 years, practicing the tenets of regenerative agriculture, sustainability, and conservation.

THE PROJECT: Interns will learn an innovative rangeland grazing method we have come to call "inherding." Traditional herding techniques will be used to help us reduce livestock & predator conflicts, regenerate rangeland ecosystems, and produce exceptional grassfed beef.

THE POSITION: Interns will spend long days herding cattle on horseback in some of the most rugged and beautiful country in the nation, living out of remote backcountry cow camps for much of the summer. Riders will be responsible for maintaining herd and rangeland health while expanding their expertise in low stress stockmanship, horsemanship, backcountry camping skills, and rangeland ecology.

THE PERSON: Tenacious, physically fit, independent, eager to learn, humble and teachable, hardworking, determined, calm under pressure, honest, and gritty. Experience and education is not necessary but will be considered. Internship credits may be arranged through your university.
