The Southwestern Region of the USDA Forest Service is hiring temporary employees for positions in administrative support, archeology, wildlife biology, wildland firefighting, timber, recreation, rangeland management, and more. The Southwestern Region of the USDA Forest Service, also known as Region 3 or R3, covers more than 20.6 million acres across Arizona, New Mexico, Oklahoma, and Texas. Region 3 is home to 11 national forests and 3 national grasslands, managed by nearly 3000 permanent and temporary employees.

In the Southwestern Region, the Forest Service is tasked with managing public lands brimming with natural resources and diverse wildlife. The Forest Service works to protect at-risk species like the Mexican spotted owl and New Mexican jumping mouse, ensure forest health through safe logging and grazing practices, and restore critical ecosystems.
